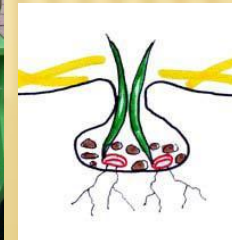
## "TOMORROW'S SOIL MUST BE PREPARED TODAY"



Ecosaen allows direct seeding. The rippled discs cut the vegetation cover and the soil.

The reversed T-shaped ploughshare (ideal for germination and taking root) and the tine set the seeding line free. The seed is placed on the bottom of the furrow, in a pocket that optimizes seedling germination.

Ecosaen respects the ecosystem, it requires 30 % less traction effort . It is an ideal tool for soil preservation.
